

## The Deity of Jesus.

We will start with Malachi 3-1. Behold I send my messenger and he shall prepare the way before Me. Who is talking here, is it not YAHWEH. This verse is about John the baptist preparing the way before Jesus' coming. So here we see straight away that this is saying Jesus is God. Isaiah says , there is no God besides me, Hebrews 1-6 says let all the angels of God worship Him [Jesus], if He was not God would the angels worship him, no, worship belongs only to God. The new world translation has changed the word worship to obeisance which is taking the true meaning away from the word. The Greek word for worship is proskuneno means to bow down to prostrate yourself, it comes from the Hebrew word , if I am right, hishtachvaya which is made up of the Hebrew letters, heh- shin-tav-chet-vav-yud-heh and means worship. So how would the angels worship a god when there is only one God. Deuteronomy 5 says I am the LORD your God who brought you out of Egypt, you shall have no other gods before me, well according to John 1.1 in the new world translation, it says, in the beginning the Word was , and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god, that means they are saying there is more than one god, all other gods are false gods. The Word in Hebrew is D var, which means matter, substance. So what we see hear is Jesus comes directly from God and is the same matter, substance as God. Some people will say how could Jesus say , the Father is greater than I if he is God. We see in Philippians 2 that Jesus was the same as God , but gave it up to become man and die for us sinners on a cross. So while He was on earth, the

Father was greater.. Now we will talk about the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is not a force as in star wars, may the force be with you. Jesus says in John many times, I have to go away because if I don't go the Helper will not come to you, but if I depart I will send Him to you, countless times referring to the Holy Spirit is HE, the Spirit of Truth, the Holy Spirit is a person and that person is God because only God is Holy. Holy-Holy-Holy, Kadosh-Kadosh-Kadosh, Father-Spirit-Son, Triunity, Echad, Jehovah's Witness's say the Holy Spirit is a force not a person. As Ephesians 4-30.31 says, do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. How can we grieve a force. Mathew 12-30 says, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven, Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him, but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come. The Greek word for blasphemos is curse, that means we would be cursing God. Jesus' resurrection was physical , He cooked fish, people say that because some did not recognize Him that He was in a different body, but the word says they were kept from recognizing Him, I think it was supernaturally done purposely till He broke the bread with them. When He was resurrected, in the garden He said to Mary, stop clinging to Me, how can you cling to a spirit. Also Luke 24 verse 39 Jesus said, behold My hands and My feet, that is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have, then He ate broiled fish and honeycomb. The Jehovah's witness's believe Jesus to be the archangel Michael , how can he be an angel when the angels worshiped Him, He is God, and there is only one God. Isaiah

is referring to Jesus as mighty God , chapter 9 verse 6, also everlasting Father. Isaiah 10 verse 21 says that the remnant of Jacob will return to the Mighty God, I AM appears in John numerous times, but in John 8 verse 58 where it says, before Abraham was, I AM. Why in the new world translation has the verse been twisted to before Abraham existed, I have been. John ch 1 verse 3 says about Jesus, All things were made through Him, without Him nothing was made that was made. Mathew 1 verse 23 says God is with us, meaning Jesus. The Bible says only God is our Savior, we all know Jesus is our Savior. In Luke Jesus showed His body to the disciples, the wounds, how could He do that if His body was destroyed as the witnesses believe. In Mathew 28 verse 19 Jesus commands His disciples to go baptizing people in the name of the Father , The Son, The Holy Spirit, do the witnesses do that, I don't think so. Jesus said, he who eats this bread and drinks my blood, the bread and wine, will gain eternal life, do the witnesses do it, NO, only for their so called anointed ones is it given the privilege.
